

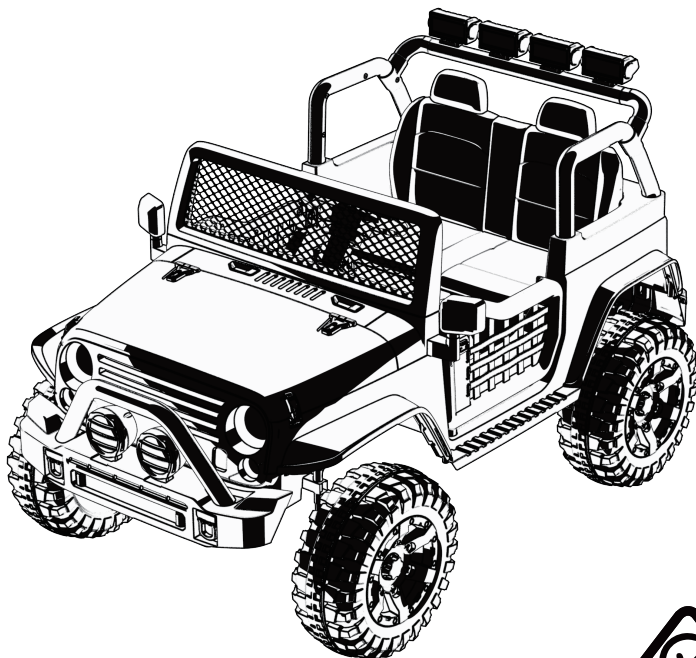

This product is a battery-operated kid car with two electric motors.

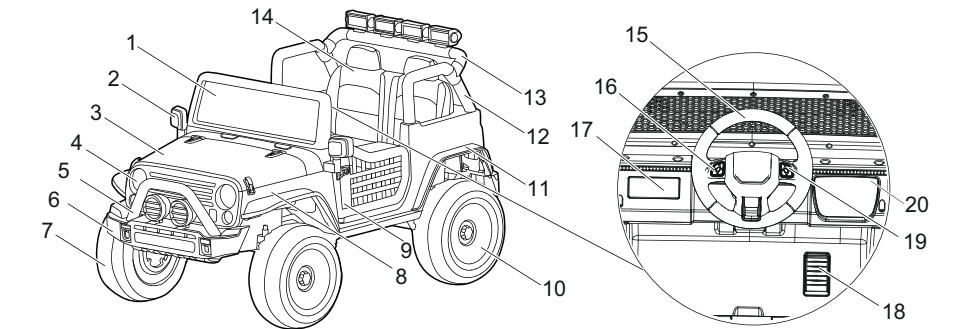

This is a recreational vehicle designed for driving on flat surfaces. Please check and consult your local state or territory laws and regulations on where you may operate this vehicle.

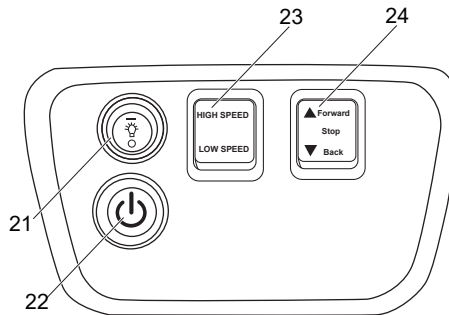

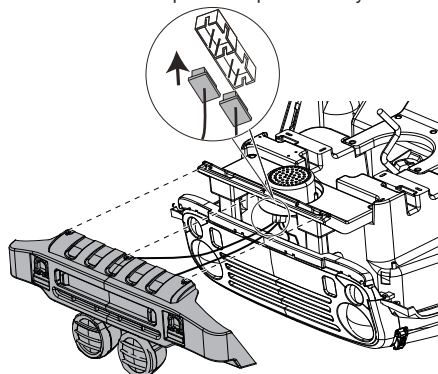

3.1 INSTALL THE FRONT BUMPER

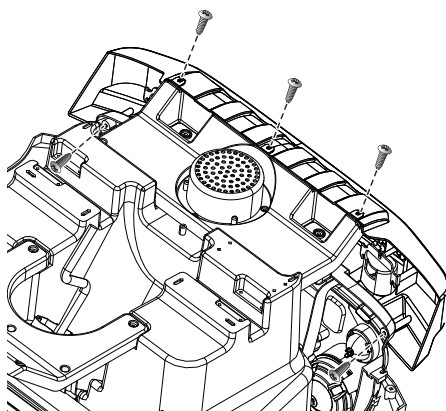
1. Turn the product upside down.

Note: Place a cardboard on floor, or use a soft surface to prevent scratching the product body.

2. Plug the connector on the front bumper into the terminal on the product body.
3. Attach the front bumper to the product body.

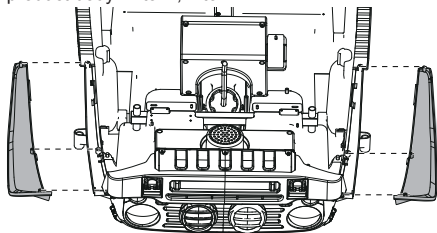


4. Align the front bumper with screw holes of the product body.
5. Securely tighten five Ø4x12 screws with a screwdriver.

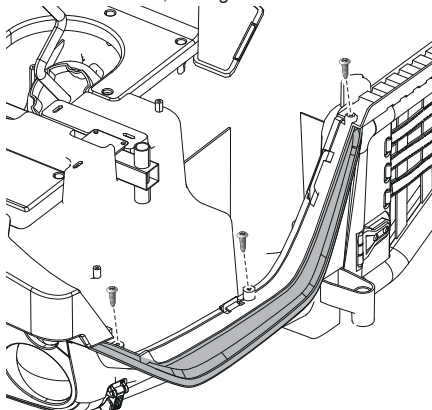


3.2 INSTALL THE FRONT & REAR FENDERS

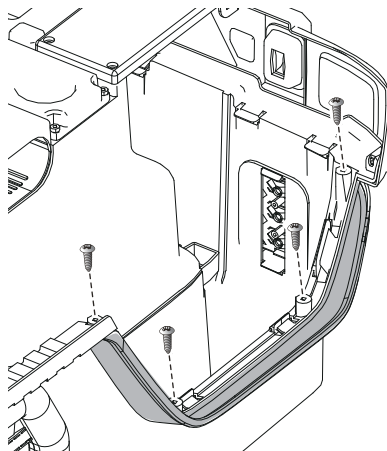
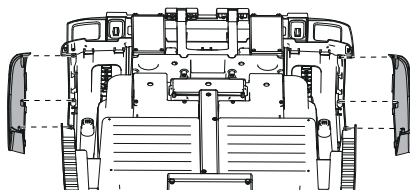
1. Install the both front fenders on each side of the product body. R to R, L to L.



2. Insert three Ø4x12 screws through the product body into the front fender, and tighten with a screwdriver.

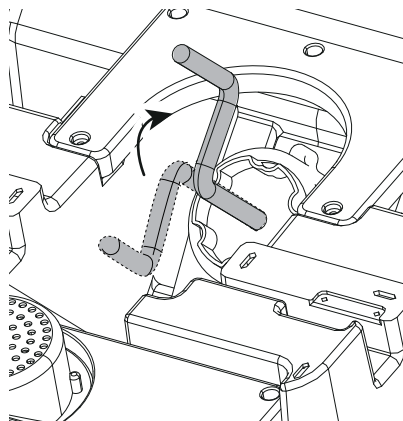


3. Install the rear fenders in the same manner as the front fenders.

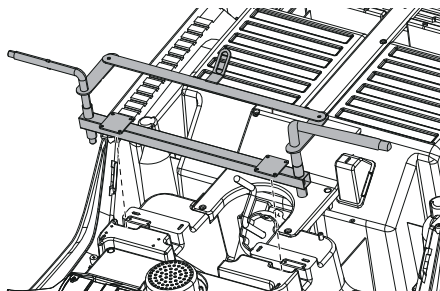


3.3 INSTALL THE FRONT WHEEL SHAFT

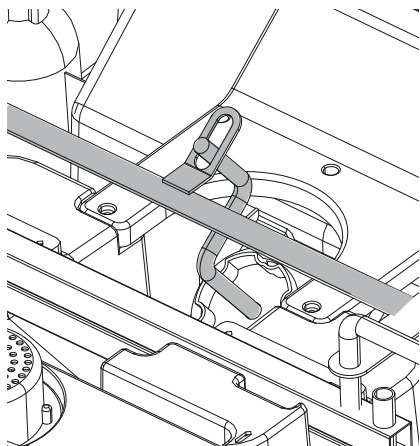
1. Rotate the front axle 180° as shown.



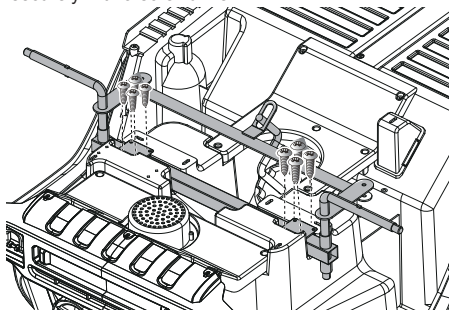
2. Place the front wheel shaft in the groove.



Note: Make sure that the front axle goes through the hole at the center of the front wheel shaft.

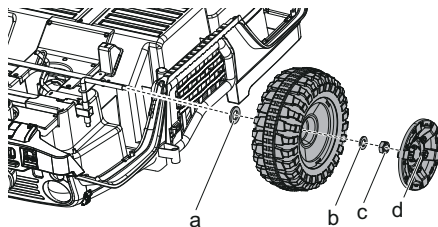


3. Insert eight Ø4x12 screws and tighten them securely with a screwdriver.



3.4 INSTALL THE FRONT WHEEL

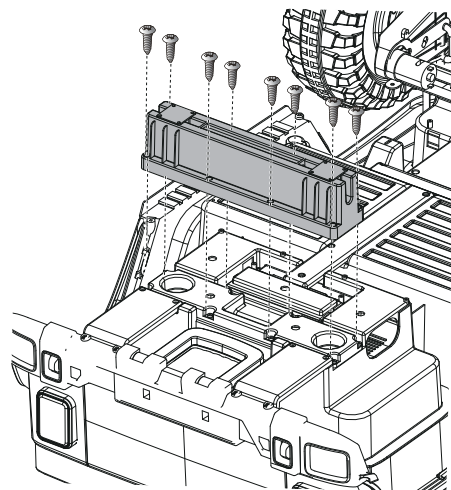
1. Slide the Ø12 washer (a), front wheel, and Ø10 washer (b) onto the front axle in order.
2. Tighten a lock nut (c) to the end of the front axle with a spanner. DO NOT over-tighten.
3. Attach the hubcap (d) to the wheel.



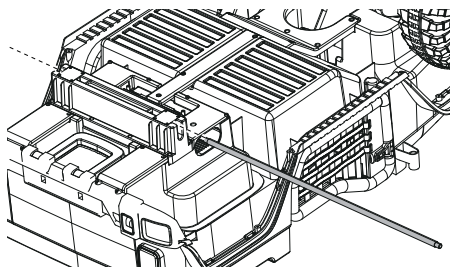
4. Repeat the above procedures to install the other front wheel.

3.5 INSTALL THE REAR WHEEL

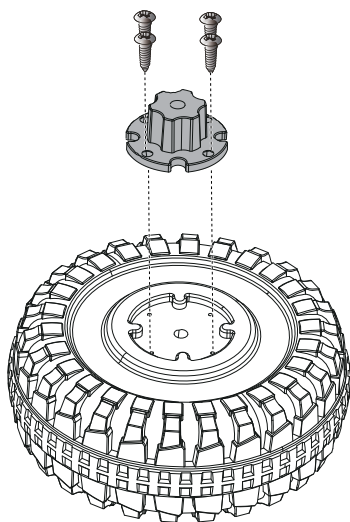
1. Install the rear wheel house onto the product body.
2. Insert eight Ø4x12 screws and tighten them securely with a screwdriver.



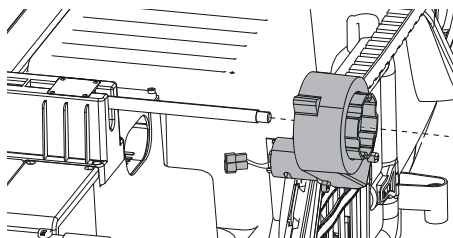
3. Insert the rear axle through the hole in the rear wheel house.



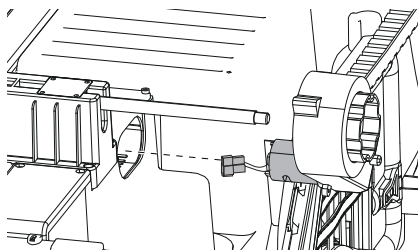
4. Install the wheel driver onto the rear wheel, and secure it with four Ø4x12 screws.



5. Slide the gear box onto the rear axle.



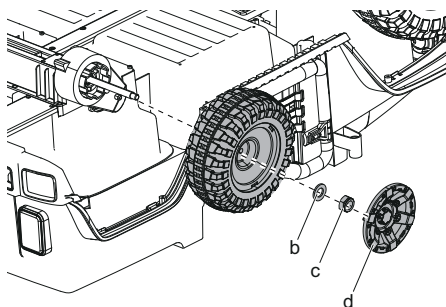
Note: Ensure the motor on the gear box passes through the hole in the product body.



6. Slide the rear wheel, Ø10 washer (b) onto the rear axle in order.

Note: The gear part on the rear wheel should match up with the gear box.

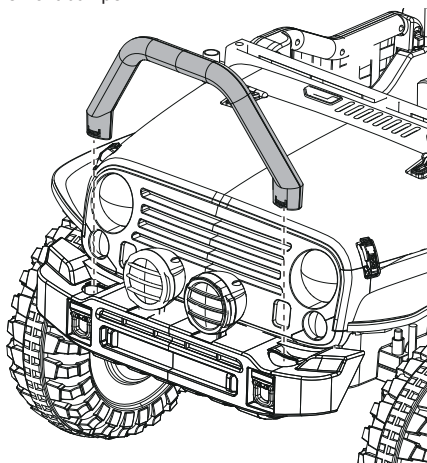
7. Tighten the lock nut (c) to the end of the front axle with a spanner. DO NOT over-tighten.
8. Install the hubcap (d) to the wheel.



9. Repeat the 4-8 procedures to assemble the other rear wheel.

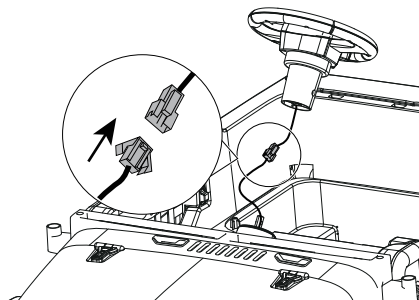
3.6 INSTALL THE FRONT ROLL BAR

1. Turn the product body upright.
2. Install the front roll bar into the holes on the top of the front bumper.



3.7 INSTALL THE STEERING WHEEL

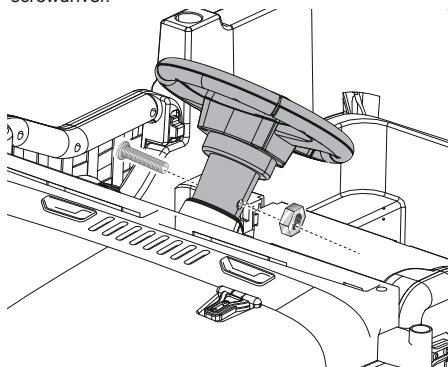
1. Plug the sound connector on the steering wheel into the connector on the product body.



2. Insert the steering wheel to the end of the steering column.

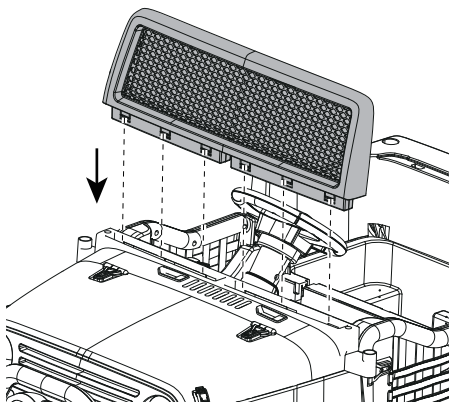
Note: Be sure to tuck the wire in the steering wheel connector when inserting the steering wheel.

3. Align the holes on the steering wheel with those on the steering column, and insert the M5x45 screw.
4. Fasten a nut on the opposite end of the screw with a screwdriver.

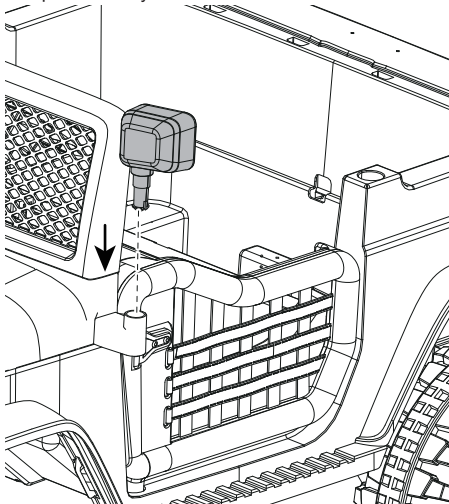


3.8 INSTALL THE WINDSHIELD & SIDEVIEW MIRROR

1. Insert the tabs on the windshield into the grooves on the product body, and push until you hear it "click" into place.

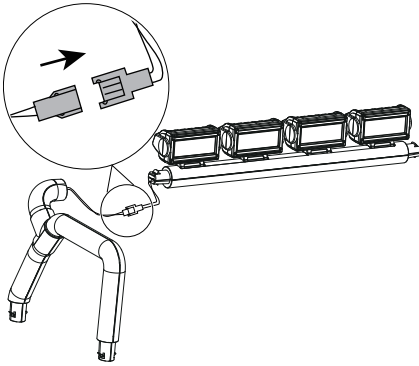


2. Insert a sideview mirror into the hole on each side of the product body.

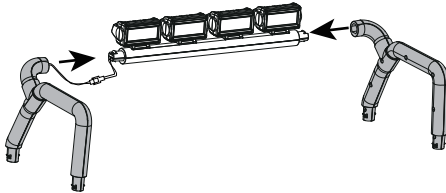

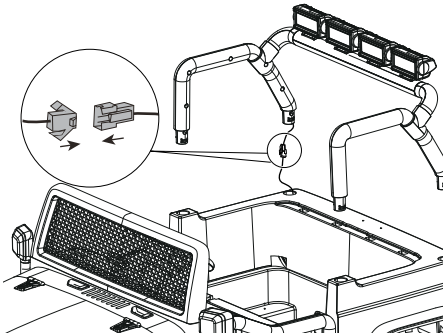

2. Install the light bar supports to the light bar.

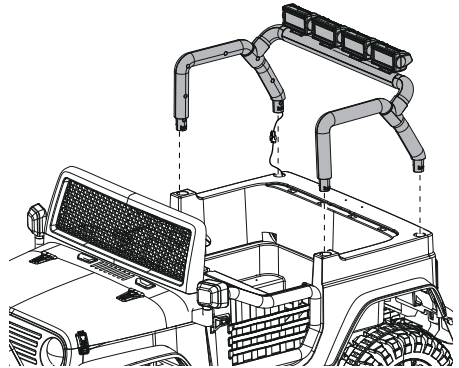

4 OPERATION

4.1 BEFORE DRIVING

4.1.1 PRE-DRIVE CHECKLIST

Make sure to check the condition of the product before each drive.

Steering wheel	• Ensure the steering wheel is correctly adjusted and tightened, allowing for proper steering.
Tires	• Ensure tires have tread and have no bulges or excessive wear. • Ensure hubs have no obvious wobbles or kinks. • Check that axle nuts are tight. • Inspect for any cracks or leaks.

4.1.2 CONNECT THE BATTERY CHARGER

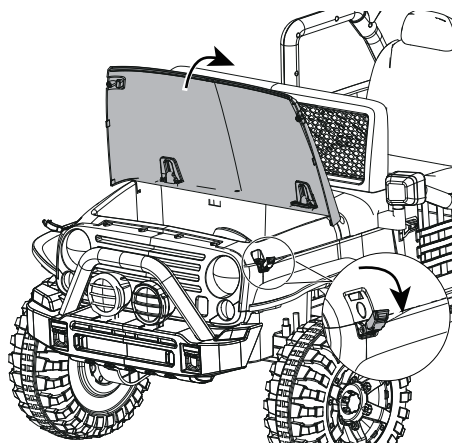

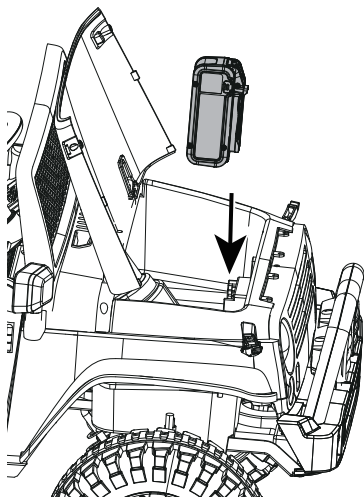

4.1.5 CONNECT THE BATTERY TO THE PRODUCT

1. Unlock and open the hood.
Note: Loosen and remove the screws to open the hood for the first time.



2. Insert the battery into the battery compartment. The battery locks into position when you hear a click.



Note: In order to start the product, make sure that the battery is charged and properly inserted into the designated compartment.

3. Close and lock the hood.

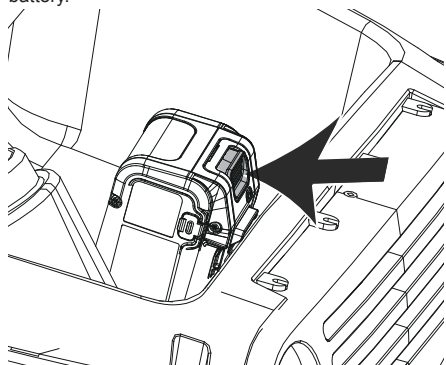
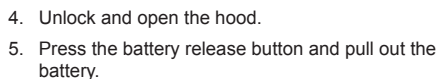
4.5.3 SPEAKER FUNCTION

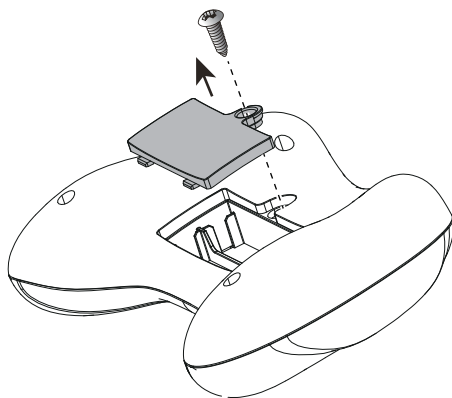
4.6 STOP THE PRODUCT

4.7 REMOTE CONTROLLER

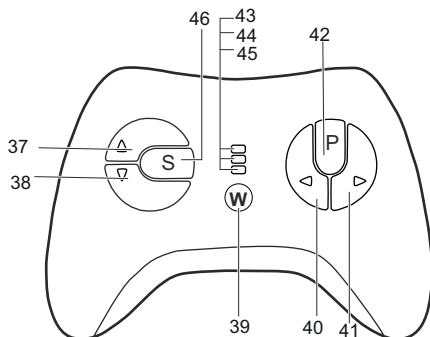

4.7.2 USE THE REMOTE CONTROLLER

This remote controller has a memory function which requires a one-time pairing to the product. There is no need to pair your remote each time the product is used, as it will remain paired even after replacing the batteries.

5.1 CLEAN THE PRODUCT

6 TRANSPORTATION, STORAGE, AND DISPOSAL

6.1 TRANSPORTATION

- In case of malfunction occurring after transport in such conditions, remove the battery and allow all parts to air-dry when you reach your destination.

6.2 STORAGE

1. Turn off the product and remove the batteries.
2. Thoroughly clean the product and then wax the painted parts with a non-abrasive automotive wax.
3. Inflate the tires with correct air pressure. Refer to *PRE-DRIVE CHECKLIST*.
4. Store the product in a covered shed or garage to protect it from dust, dirt and humidity. If the product must be stored outdoors, cover it completely with a waterproof cover.
5. Store the product in a safe place to prevent theft.
